



For learners who are interested in learning about child development

Family Learning are offering an 8 week online course with a qualification attached. This means you will have a virtual session (using Microsoft Teams) once a week with a tutor and other learners where you will learn about child development.

There will be assessment activities that you will need to complete and submit back to your tutor for review. Your tutor will arrange to contact you regularly and will upload supporting information to help you complete the activities – there are no essays required, I promise !

You can achieve either a **Level 1 or Level 2 Award in Skills for Working in Child Care Industries** from the national awarding body **Aim Awards** (www.aimawards.org.uk).

A **Level 1** qualification is equivalent to a level 1-3 GCSE (previously grades D-G).
A **Level 2** qualification is equivalent to a level 4-9 GCSE (previously grades A*-C).

We will work through the following units to achieve enough credits to gain the above qualification (at whichever level suits you).

- **The Intellectual and Language Development of Children**

This unit covers how children develop intellectually and acquire communication skills.

- **Children's Social and Emotional Development**

This unit includes behavioural issues and how to manage them as well as considering the needs of children with SEN.

The 1½ hour virtual sessions will be on a Wednesday morning, from 10-11.30am and the course will start on Wednesday 14th April.
