Year 1 Phonics Screening Test

The Year 1 phonics screening check is not a formal test, but a way for teachers to ensure that children are making sufficient progress with their phonics skills to read words and that they are on track to become fluent readers who can enjoy reading for pleasure and for learning. Year 1 children usually take the phonics screening check in early June alongside Year 2 children who did not meet the expected level in their year 1 screening. Vocabulary Corner

Today we focus on: **PE**

This half term the children are learning about Athletics. Here are some important words the children will be learning:

Relay - a race between teams in which each team member covers a certain part of the course

Sprint - a short run at top speed

Underarm throw - a single-handed throw of an object e.g. a ball or beanbag where the object is thrown below the shoulder and swinging your arm backwards

Overhead throw - a single-handed throw of an object e.g. a ball or beanbag where the object is thrown above the shoulder
