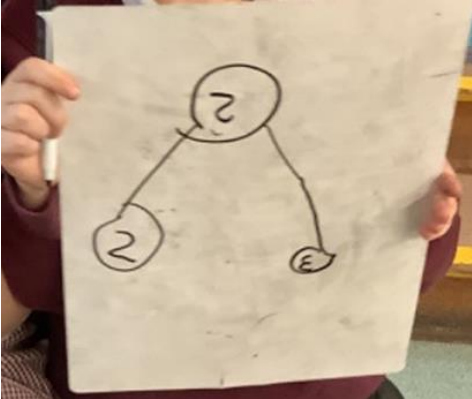

Spotlight on Learning

Year R

In Maths, the Year R children have been learning about combining groups to make numbers. Here's an example of a part-whole model:



In Literacy, the children have been learning about sea creatures and what we can do to keep our oceans clean. They decided that we can all make a difference by putting our rubbish in the bin.

Year 1

This week, Woodpeckers and Badgers have been counting in tens in Maths. In English, the children have been exploring rhyme in traditional nursery rhymes. Why not see if you can recite some together at home?

Year 2

In PSHE Year 2 have been learning about money and that you need to save money when you want to buy something more expensive. The children understood that they needed to make decisions such as not going to the cinema and watch a film at home instead in order to save money for something else they wanted. They also looked at things we WANT to spend money on and things we NEED to spend money on.

In computing they have been planning routes and testing and debugging with the Beebots. The children understood how to recognise the mistake in the algorithm and change it so it was correct.
