Spotlight on Learning

YR

In Maths the children have been consolidating their understanding of composition. This means knowing that numbers are made up of adding 2 or more smaller numbers together.

In Literacy there has been a R.E focus: 'Which stories are special and why?'

The highlight of the week was the trip and meeting lots of new friends!

Y1

In Maths the children have been exploring tens and ones to 100 and comparing numbers using the vocabulary "greater than" and "less than".

In English they have been exploring stories from different cultures and have read *The Old Woman and The Red Pumpkin*.

In History the children have been thinking about the features of a seaside holiday.

Y2

This week in English, Year 2 started their unit on instruction writing. They have given instructions orally on how to put on a costume and had a practice at writing some. Next week they will be planting a sunflower and then writing instructions independently.

In Maths, they have started learning about collecting data using tally charts and tables. They have represented data in block diagrams and pictograms. They have enjoyed asking each other about their favourite things!

In Science, the children are continuing to learn about plants with a focus on the conditions of growth. They have planted bean seeds in different conditions such as no light or no water and discussed how they will grow.

In History, they have been detectives looking at images and deciding what they know to be true from the images. They have begun learning about who Rosa Parks was and what she is known for in history.

In PSHE, the children have begun learning about changes and thinking about the question 'What are the big changes in my life?' They read the book *Changes* by Anthony Browne which explores their idea of a new baby sister.
