
Spotlight on Learning

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This week the children have been innovating "The Three Little Pias."

The children performed their story to year 2 and Year 2 performed "The True Story of The Three Little Pigs."

In Maths the children have continued learning their number bonds to 10. The children have started to write number sentences to match their sums.



Y1

This week Year 1 had a special message in a bottle delivered which said 'The pirates are coming! Quick! Everybody hide!' The children wrote their own stories about pirates and the next day found a golden treasure package with a book inside!

In Maths they have been learning to measure objects using cubes, and comparing objects using the words longer, shorter and taller.

The children are now learning about Queen Victoria and have been finding out about what life was like for people living at the time she was alive. They didn't like the idea of the cane being used in schools, or having to go outside to the toilet!

In English this week, Year 2 have been planning their alternative version of a traditional tale in order to create a warning tale in the style of 'The True Story of the Three Little Pigs'.

They have had a very exciting week of history in readiness for their brilliant trip to the King Richard III Visitor Centre on Thursday. At school the children re-enacted the Battle of Bosworth and then became archaeologists to discover how King Richard III might have died all those years ago by examining his skeleton. On Thursday they were then lucky enough to go and see how his remains were discovered in Leicester. We also learnt about the reliability of different sources to decide whether we thought King Richard III was a good or a bad king. What a fantastic experience it was!
